Lady Helen, a talented young novelist, takes center stage in “To the Ends of the World”. When she arrives in Wild Rose Valley to visit her brother David, she runs into James instead, the man who broke her heart back in England. While Helen and James rediscover their love for one another in the wilderness, manslaughter, financial ruin, and a dark family secret nearly succeed in keeping them apart...

Mystery infuses “To Forsake for Love” as Grace, a young frontier doctor, finds an injured man in the woods who only seems to remember that he was travelling with his son. A search party finds the boy, whose father, Jeremy, turns out to be the town’s new schoolteacher. He and Grace fall in love, but Jeremy is keeping some important secrets from her.
