

# Kwanza's iceberg documentary gets warm reception from ZDF

GERMAN broadcaster ZDF this week climbed aboard *Ice Dreams* (1 x 52 mins HD), a documentary from production and distribution company Kwanza about a new attempt

to use icebergs for drinking water. "Since the 1960s, many attempts have been made to tow icebergs to drought-stricken countries," said Kwanza's Benjamin Ternynck, who

is producing the documentary. "But only now is it becoming possible to do it, and the attempt in 2010 could succeed."

Ternynck's documentary will track the project using HD, 3D animation, and a specialist camera mounted on a hot-air balloon.

"Very few broadcasters can mount such a lavish production alone," said ZDF Enterprises' co-productions and development documentaries manager Nikolas Hulbusch. "So to us, co-production makes sense."

The addition of ZDF brings to 12 the number of broadcasters now on-board. Ternynck is still looking for a US partner.
