

ZDF's new adventures

TOPPING ZDF Enterprises' children's film slate for MIPCOM is *Stella And The Star Of The Orient*, in which a 10-year-old girl is transported back to the early 20th century to search for a precious stone. New animation series from ZDF include *The Jungle Book* (52 x 11 mins/1 x 60 mins), a 3D HD version of Rudyard Kipling's novel targeted at six- to nine-year-olds; *Marsupilami* (52 x 26 mins), which continues the jungle capers of the fictional long-tailed creature; *Igam Ogam* (26 x 10 mins), a stop-frame comedy series for toddlers set in the Stone Age; and *Fun With Claude* (52 x 10 mins), which features an inquisitive polar bear cub whose family have moved to a sunny new town.
